Admissions process

REGISTRATION

Parents who wish to register their children for 3+ entry should complete the online registration form which can be found in the Admissions section of the school website: princesgardensprep.co.uk

ASSESSMENTS

Dates are to be confirmed in the term preceding the relevant assessment. Nursery readiness assessments for entry to the school in September and November 2020, will take place at Baden Powell House. All other assessments will take place at Prince's Gardens Preparatory School.

NURSERY READINESS ASSESSMENTS

The purpose of the assessment is to ensure that children offered places will thrive during their time at Prince's Gardens Preparatory School. The sessions are run by our Head of Pre-Prep, who will spend time getting to know each child as an individual. The sessions are fun, engaging, age-appropriate and interactive. During the readiness assessment we will be looking at children's fundamental skills in investigation and enquiry, general social skills, as well as cooperation, perseverance and resilience. Sessions will be 20 minutes in length and will be followed by a meeting with either the Head of Pre-Prep or Headmistress.

OFFER OF PLACES

An email will be sent to all applicants advising of the outcome and hard copy letters will follow, within one week of a child's readiness assessment.

PLACE ACCEPTANCE

The deadline for accepting the offer of a place for Nursery at Prince's Gardens Preparatory School will be two weeks from the date of the offer letter.
